specialization:University offers Dual Specialization in MBA Program. All the courses of Semester I and II are compulsory. Students have to secure Major and Minor Specialization in Semester III and IV.

There will be 3 courses for Major area of specialization and 1 course for Minor area of specialization in Semester III. And there will be 2 courses for Major area of specialization and 1 course for Minor area of specialization in Semester IV.

For Major Specialization to be awarded, one has to earn total 15 credits or more in any of the three areas of specialization. Minor Specialization will be awarded if one has earned total 6 credits or more in any of the four areas of specialization. The areas available for specialization are (A) Finance (B) Human Resources Management# (C) International Business# (D) Marketing #Available only for Minor Specialization
